

checkbook cover

WHAT YOU NEED:

1 fat quarter - outer fabric
1 fat quarter - lining fabric
1/2 yard fusible interfacing
Matching thread

WHAT YOU DO:

1. Cut one of outer and lining fabrics:
7 1/2" x 14"
2. Cut two of fusible interfacing: 7 1/2" x 14". Fuse to wrong sides of outer fabric and lining fabric.
3. With right sides together, using a 1/4" seam allowance, stitch around fabric. Leave a 5" opening on one short end for turning. Clip corners to remove bulk and turn right sides out. Press well, being sure to press under the 1/4" seam allowance in the opening.
4. Edgestitch 1/8" from each short end. This step finishes the edges and closes your opening.
5. Turn under 2 3/4" on each short end to form pockets for checkbook and register. Pin to hold in place.
6. On the outside of checkbook cover, edgestitch 1/8" all the way around, making sure to catch all layers in stitching.
7. Fold in half and press.
