



## Clean Slime

### Ingredients

- 1 Tsp Borax
- 1 Cup White Glue
- 1 Cup Water
- 2 Cups Corn Starch
- Food Color

### Directions:

1. Borax is available in the laundry section of your local grocery store. Take a ½ cup of water and add to it 1 tsp. of borax (approx 4% solution). Stir until completely dissolved, then add food coloring.\*
2. Make a white glue solution by mixing ½ cup of white glue with 1 cup of water to thin glue.
3. In a Ziploc bag or bowl, add equal parts of the borax solution to equal parts of the glue solution. 1 cup of each will make 2 cups of slime.
4. Seal bag and knead the mixture with hands. Or use your hands in a bowl and mix.
5. After it is super slimy and mixed well, slowly add cornstarch and knead again. This will keep it from being sticky, have the same properties as oobleck but feel slimy still and not separate.

\*if you find that your mixture is not coming together after vigorous mixing and knead, add a pinch or two of borax to the mixture at time. Just be care not to add too much or you'll end up with rubber.
