

snap wallet

WHAT YOU NEED:

remnant - outer fabric
remnant - lining fabric
1/4 yard fusible interfacing
matching thread
snap or velcro

WHAT YOU DO:

1. Cut one of outer and lining fabrics:
5" x 8".
2. Cut two of fusible interfacing: 5" x 8". Fuse to wrong sides of outer fabric and lining fabric.
3. With right sides together, using a 1/4" seam allowance, stitch around fabric, leaving a 3" opening on one long side for turning. (If desired, you may round two of the corners for a different look.) Clip corners to remove bulk and turn right sides out. Press well, being sure to press under the 1/4" seam allowance in the opening.
4. Turn up about 2 3/4" on one short end for wallet and press. Pin to hold in place.
6. On the outside of wallet, edgestitch 1/8" all the way around, making sure to catch all layers in stitching. This step will also close up the opening you left for turning the wallet.
7. Fold down the flap of your wallet and press.
8. Apply your snap or velcro closure.
